Renewal – Footpath Program

Identification

Footpaths play a crucial role in the Rural City of Murray Bridge by providing vital access to schools, shopping, community facilities, services and open space. The presence of footpaths enhances community liveability and connectivity, while also promoting a healthier, more physically active lifestyle

The Purpose

The objectives of the footpath renewal program in the Rural City of Murray Bridge are to:

- Promote walking as a sustainable and preferred mode of transport for short trips, including work, shopping, school and recreation
- Reduce conflicts between pedestrians and motor vehicles
- Enhance the amenity, accessibility and safety of the footpath network, ensuring it is usable for all

Current Condition/Scenario

Footpath Renewal Program (ARFR)

For 2024-25, \$113,433 is allocated within the Civil and Transport Infrastructure Asset Management Plan for footpath renewal. This funding targets improvements to non-compliant pram ramps and various footpath segments throughout the Rural City of Murray Bridge.
